Full Text Search : does this work? only for mysql? what's the advantage?

what are differences between search\_box tiki-searchresults.php and search\_new tiki-searchindex.php?

### Answer

There are 2 different full text search engines. One uses the mysql builtin fulltext index. This has to be activated and compiled in into your mysql server. You have to run additional sql scripts to build the fulltext index. The other one is a handmade, database independant search function. This is more limited but fast. If you use the "search" module, you get the mysql specific, if you use "search\_new" then you get the database independant one. See also SearchDev. redflo.
